

GILDA B.

A timeless chair, elegant and flowing. A creation of the artist Jacopo Foggini, obtained by modeling manually polycarbonate. Gilda B. is the second of the series began in 2014, with Gina. Same wooden legs inspired by mid-century design and varnished black, semi-gloss. Monocoque in polycarbonate as transparent as a crystal embellished with ancient "sediment oxides" in amber tones of cognac or tobacco leaves. As a Murano glass but with strong irregularities that make the matter more alive. It is named after Gilda Bojardi, editor-in-chief of *Interni*.

It is produced in a single color version. Each piece is handmade with technologies developed by the same artist and is therefore a unique specimen, strongly different from all the others.

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
